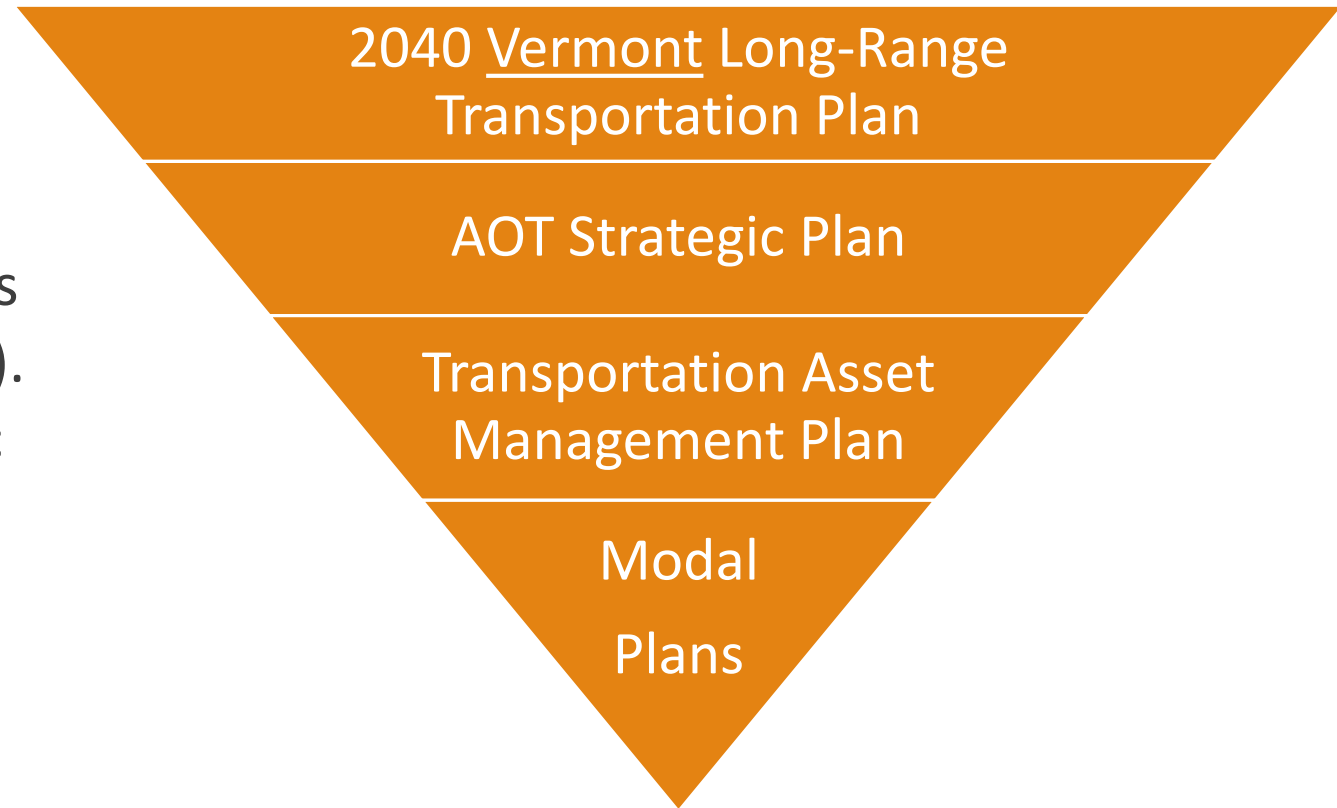

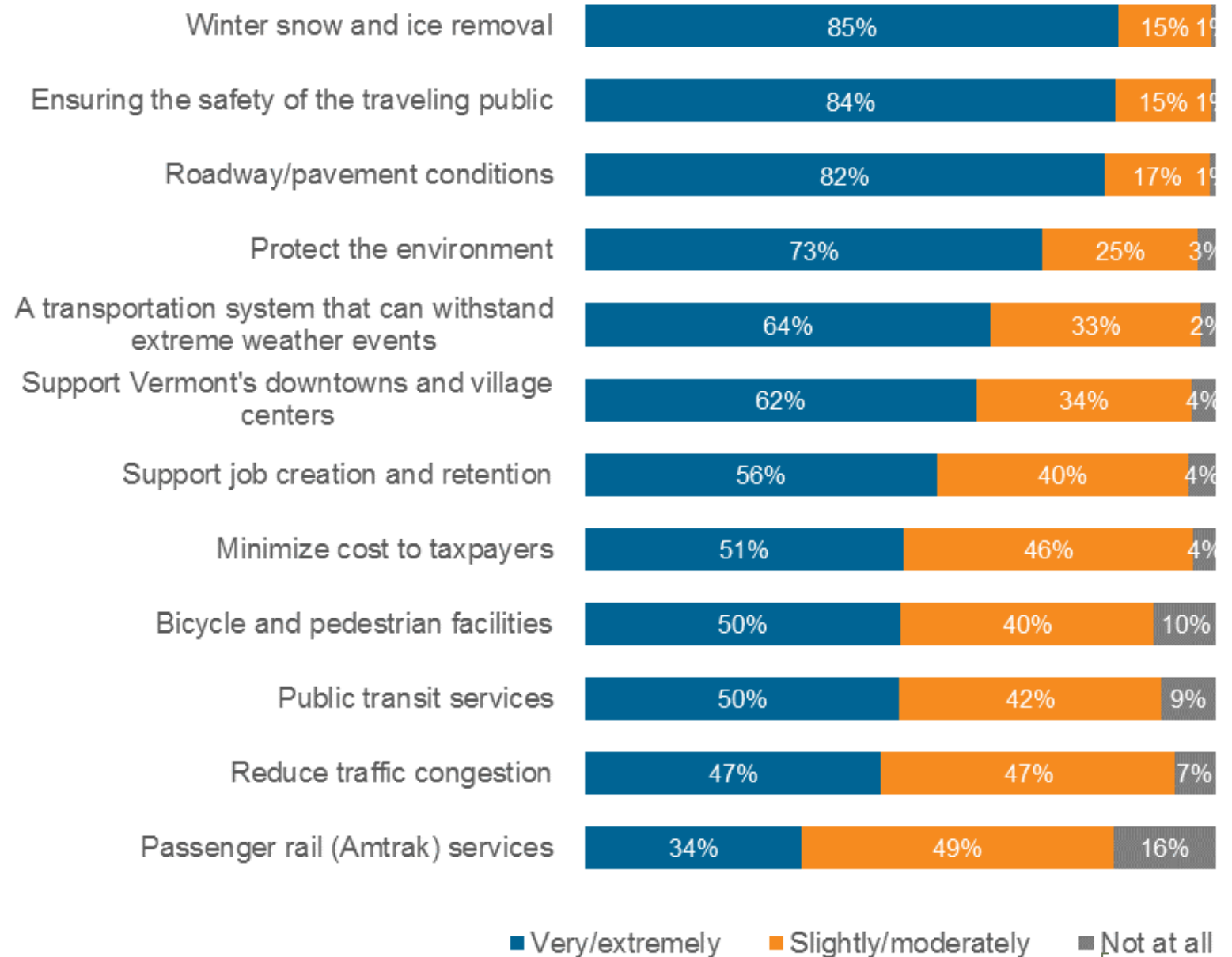
L RTP Purpose and Context

1. Sets broad priorities for transportation decision-making and investments over the next 20 years.
2. Addresses changes in federal policies (over 50% of transportation funding).
3. Guides the development of strategic and modal plans.
4. Updated periodically to ensure we are pursuing the right path in terms of policies and investment priorities.

- criticality assessment - the importance of an asset to transportation network function and critical facility access
- risk rating - the combination of vulnerability consequences and asset importance
- initial prioritization of mitigation strategies to reduce hazards

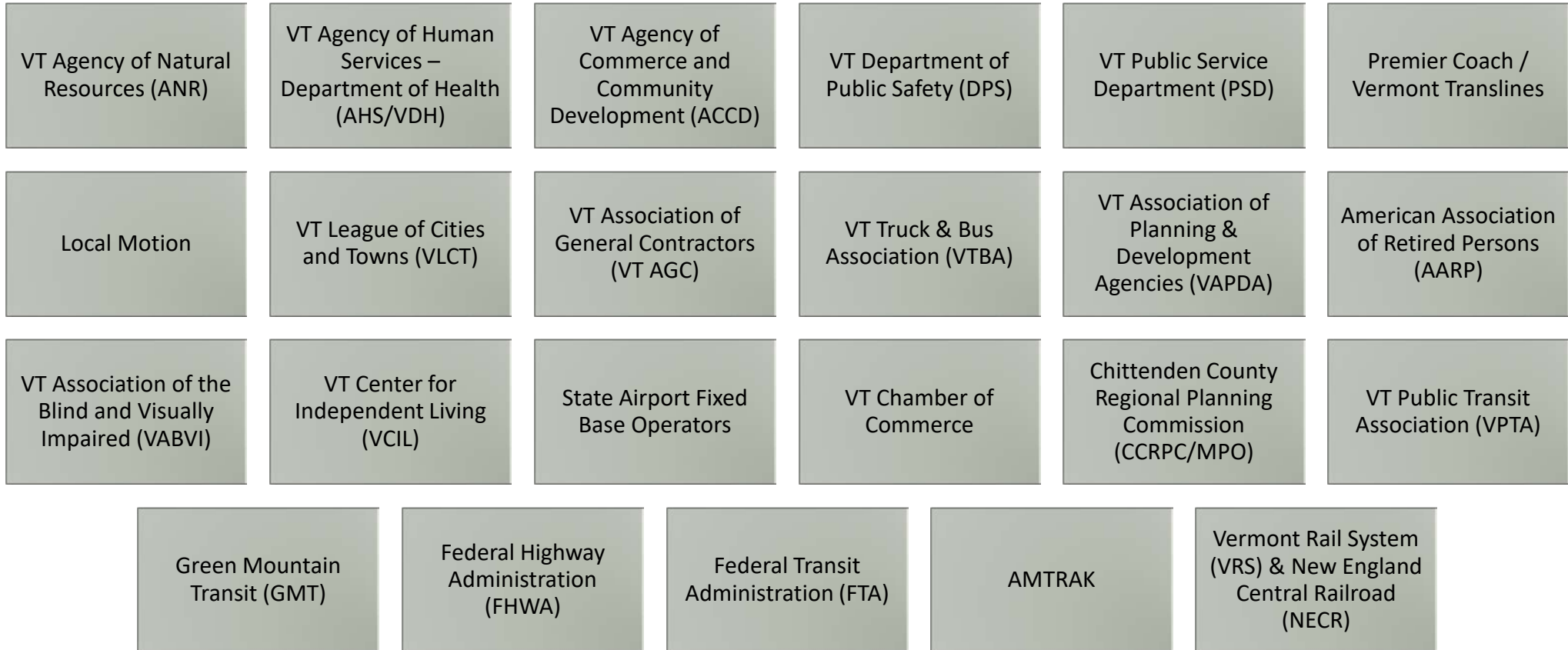
