LOCATION: PITTSFIELD BHF 022-1 (24) - ON VT 100 BEGINNING APPROXIMATELY 1.20 MILES SOUTH OF THE STOCKBRIDGE/PITTSFIELD TOWN LINE AND EXTENDING NORTHERLY APPROXIMATELY 0.042 MILES.

TYPE OF CONSTRUCTION: WORK TO BE PERFORMED UNDER THIS PROJECT INCLUDES REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING BRIDGE ALONG WITH RELATED APPROACH ROADWAY AND CHANNEL WORK.
