## Minutes:

- EAA Update
  - April 30<sup>th</sup> rally / 22 kids ages 9-12 were given rides by 4 pilots
  - June 11<sup>th</sup> Young Eagle flights 9am-12pm
  - Youth Protection Training mandatory June 1<sup>st</sup>
- Lyle/Tyler
  - RECD, The Mayor's Office and the Planning Commission meeting scheduled May 31<sup>st</sup>
  - Focusing on Hangar development, approaching the industrial park to attract a company that may utilize the airport.
  - Reviewing ski area incentives
  - Estimating real-estate values
- Planning Grant
  - Vermont Development Planning Corp (VDPC)
  - Clarendon would develop and apply for the grant
- Airport Updates
  - Taxiway A should be in the new AFD as well as 320 feet to RWY 1 take off distance
  - Remaining A will be constructed in two phases starting on 2017.
    - Phase one: Tie into runway 19
    - Phase two: Tie existing taxiway A to new tie in
- Solar Array in April produced 9,000kwh. So far in May it has produced 11,888kwh. Over \$6,000 in credits. We estimate \$40,000 for the year.
