The Technical Evaluation Committee was comprised of seven highly qualified engineers from Structures, Roadway, Local Transportation Facilities, and Materials and Research.

The D-B Teams were numerically rated, on a 100 point scale, based upon the content, quality and applicability of their proposals as follows:

Tetra Tech Construction, Inc. / URS, Corp.	77.98

The numerical ratings for the above Teams will form 40% of the overall rating scores in the selection process. The bids will comprise up to the remaining 60% with the lowest bid receiving a 60. Bids will be opened on December 5, 2012 at which time the determination of one apparent Best Value Team will be made. Following confirmation of bid and RFP requirements a recommendation for Best Value Team will be forwarded to you for approval.
