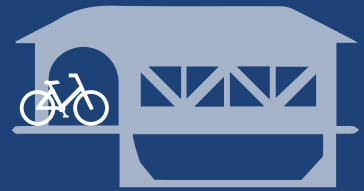


VTRANS ON-ROAD BICYCLE PLAN

Join us to help improve bicycling in Vermont

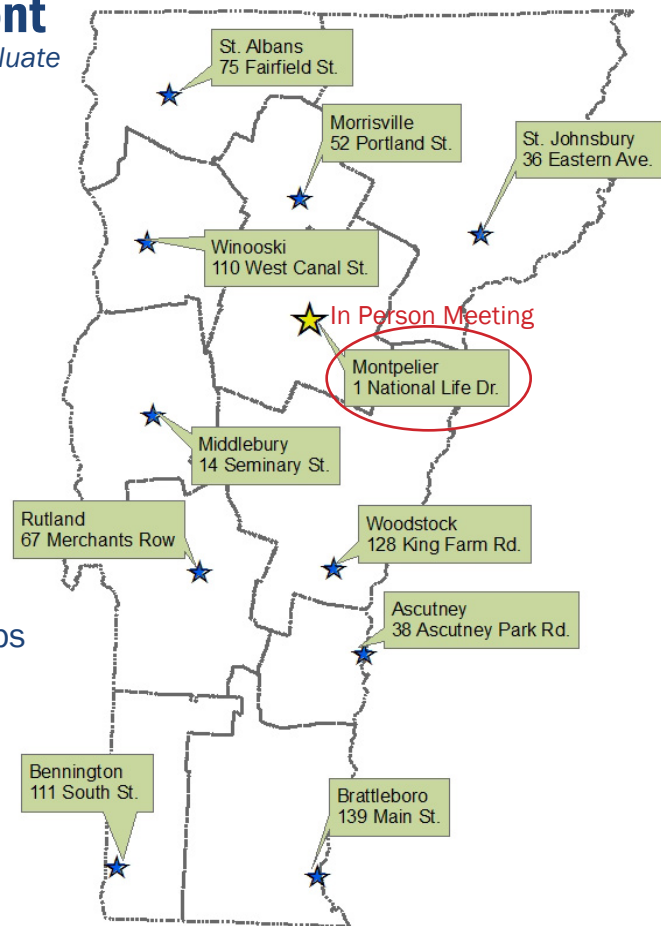
The Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) seeks your help to evaluate high-use bicycle corridors. Spread the word to friends and neighbors!

WHAT:

- 1) Learn about the statewide VTrans On-Road Bicycle Plan Phase II
- 2) Review identified bicycle safety hotspots
- 3) Learn about upcoming opportunities to provide feedback on what makes roads feel comfortable and to identify network gaps

- Participate via an interactive crowdsourcing map to provide feedback on the draft gap analysis

Phase 1: (Completed)

Created priority bicycle corridors based on bicycle use

Phase 2: (Underway)

Identify on-road facility gaps for the high use/priority corridors and bicycle safety hot spots on all state roads

Phase 3: (TBD)

Identify improvement strategies along high-use bicycle corridors and develop an implementation plan
