



## **Crowdsourcing Vermont's First On-Road Bike Plan**

VTTrans is developing an On-Road Bike Plan for Vermont to ensure the highest level of safety and strong infrastructure for cyclists and motorists sharing our roads. We are using a combination of public input and existing road data to prioritize bike infrastructure projects on the roads that cyclists use the most, and ones that they would like to use if the roadway could safely accommodate them. And we're reaching out to the public in new ways to get a better picture of what the future can look like.

One of the ways that VTTrans gathered public input on the plan was via an innovative [Wiki Mapping Project](#) that allowed users to add comments on individual road segments using an interactive map. More than 2,000 people participated, offering comments and suggestions on road segments throughout the state.

VTTrans is also conducting statewide meetings to gather information from the public using Vermont Interactive Television. One meeting has already occurred, and a second meeting will be held on April 30, 6-8 pm. VTTrans also gathered extensive public input via an innovative [Wiki Mapping Project](#) that allowed users to add comments on individual road segments an. More than 2,000 people participated, offering comments and suggestions on road segments throughout the state.

Once we've gathered information from the public, we'll merge it with existing road data to help prioritize projects based on cyclists' needs and existing road conditions. By using this information in the planning of new projects and maintenance, we can make more informed decisions about where to focus our investments to make the state's highways work better for everyone.
