



Vermont Local Roads Joins VTrans

On September 1st, 2014 the Vermont Local Roads program officially transitioned from its original home at St. Michael's College to the VTrans Training Center (VTTC) in Belin. Vermont Local Roads has provided a unique service to the communities of Vermont since its beginning in 1982 and its functions will remain unchanged: providing technical, environmental, equipment, safety and supervisory support and trainings to municipalities throughout the State of Vermont but now with the support and resources provided by VTrans.

In January Kevin Gadapee (kevin.gadapee@state.vt.us) joined Vermont Local Roads as the Branch Manager replacing Paul Keegan who acted as interim manager during the transition. Paul successfully moved the program to its new location, while continuing to provide the necessary technical help and support to the 255 Municipalities of Vermont.

Kevin joins Vermont Local Roads with more than 15 years in public service, recently serving as the Highway Foreman for the Town of Danville. Kevin was joined by Todd Eaton (todd.eaton@state.vt.us) in February who was hired as the full-time Circuit Rider for the program. Both Todd and Kevin will be visiting towns across Vermont seeking input and assisting towns as needed with their surface transportation needs.

In addition, a Program Coordinator, Holly Hayden (holly.hayden@state.vt.us) will function as strategic administrative and daily operational support for the Vermont Local Roads program.
