Contractor Work and Traffic Impacts

Work is expected to begin this month, though the contractor has not been given the notice to proceed on work yet. The contractor has mobilized some construction materials and equipment in the northwest parking area.

The contractor is created a traffic control plan and has submitted it to Vtrans. It is currently under review at Vtrans. A future impact is that US-4 will be reduced to one lane of alternating traffic during construction. The Project Team will keep the public notified as to the timing of the plan approval and traffic disruption.
