

Construction Update Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project Week of November 5-9

With the trenching of Merchants Row and paving of the Main Street (Route 30) bridge in Middlebury completed, it's almost back to normal in downtown Middlebury.

Next week the pedestrian pathway connecting Marble Works to the footbridge over Otter Creek will be temporarily closed Monday or Tuesday, weather depending, so that the gravel pathway can be paved. This summer the contractor created a gravel roadway on top of the existing paved pedestrian pathway to allow construction vehicles access to the outfall area.

Throughout the week there may be brief, intermittent delays as construction vehicles enter and exit the work zone at Triangle Park.
