

Construction Update

Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project

DATE: April 23, 2021

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Construction vehicles will moving in and out of Triangle Park and Printer's Alley on Main Street. Pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers should proceed with caution. The crew is managing traffic on Main Street as needed. Construction vehicles are traveling in and out of the Fifield Farm marshaling yard on Route 30 just south of town.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Next week, Landshapes will set granite pavers in Triangle Park. Crews will finish construction of the hardscape in the lower section of the park except for one sidewalk panel on the Main Street side. Kubricky will plant grass seed in the upper section of the park. The fountain is being restored and will be reinstalled later this Spring. Triangle Park is nearing completion!

In Printer's Alley, Waters completed the new sidewalk that connects the Marble Works and Main Street. A temporary gravel sidewalk is available for pedestrians until the new one is ready for use. Kubricky will pour footings and then start forming and pouring the retaining wall in Lazarus Park.
