
Construction Update

Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project

DATE: May 7, 2021

TRAFFIC IMPACT: Construction vehicles will continue entering and exiting Printer's Alley and the Marble Works from Main Street and Seymour Street. Pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers should proceed with caution. This applies to the Fifield Farm marshaling yard as well.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:

Next week, crews will pour concrete to form the retaining wall in Lazarus Park. Waters will continue forming and pouring the sidewalk past the labyrinth and into the Marble Works. To the north of Printer's Alley along the rail corridor, ECI continued forming and pouring concrete cap walls that create a top piece for the U-walls.

Kubricky will pour concrete to form a retaining wall behind the Smith Housing Partnership building. In late May, Landshapes will install the final granite pavers, and Kubricky will plant grass in the green space of Triangle Park.
