LOCATION: BEGINNING IN THE TOWN OF POULTNEY ON VERMONT ROUTE 30 AT STATION 278+00.00 (MM 5.265) AND EXTENDING NORTHERLY APPROXIMATELY 500.00 FEET (0.095 MILE) TO STATION 283+00.00 (MM 5.359).

TYPE OF CONSTRUCTION: WORK TO BE PERFORMED UNDER THIS PROJECT INCLUDES RECONSTRUCTION, SLOPE STABILIZATION, LEDGE REMOVAL, DRAINAGE AND OTHER HIGHWAY RELATED ITEMS.
