Meeting called to order at noon.

- Young Eagles/EAA planning event giving rides to kids on Saturday, September 19th.
Could possibly affect CAP flying event planned for same day.
Extensive discussion about promotion of various air activities – glider weekend, an Ace Camp, other. Should start planning now for an event next year.
- Altius application for RUT-HPN service considered complete. Advisable to develop a marketing plan for empty backhauls, and to involve the Chamber in promotion of the service.
- RWYISA project ahead of schedule,.
- West-side hangar development: A private organization has submitted a plan for a hangar large enough to accommodate several corporate/private planes. Often pilots want their own, w/o the middle man. Long-term plan needed for how this will be handled going forward.
- Solar array project moving along nicely. Will not interfere with runway space.
- Electrical improvements to State hangar completed.
- AWOS: The stand-by AWOS trailer needed here so we can work on repairs in August may not be available. If it is, great – if not, repairs will have to be postponed.
- Website upgrade has begun. More information needed.
- Signage project for the airport starting in August.
- Trees overhanging the CAP building soon to be cut.
