

Quechee Gorge Bridge Construction Update



Construction Update

Workers closed the eastbound travel lane of the Quechee Gorge Bridge this past week. We understand that the timing was not ideal, particularly because of the solar eclipse. We hope that you enjoyed time with family and friends during this great event!

Our goal is get the bridge repaired as safely and quickly as possible. With the closure, there are several features that have already been implemented. They include:

- Eastbound lane closure;
- Alternating travel over the bridge, controlled by a traffic signal;
- Concrete barrier, to separate motorists from the workers; and
- New paint lines on the roadway.

These items will be in place through October / November of 2024.

Please remember that workers too want to get work done as quickly and safely as possible through our short construction season. Weather has not been our friend! Please encourage all drivers to be patient and remember that that this work is required to get the Quechee Gorge Bridge functioning as safely, efficiently, and quickly as possible.

For those traveling by foot, the trail is closed at the bridge underpass through the fall of 2025. The adjacent trail is open via a signed detour through the visitor center. Like last year, the contractor is using the southwest parking area

as a staging site.
