Purpose:

To provide standardized guidance to agency personnel, consultants and all groups dealing with the Agency of Transportation regarding highway engineering and design issues.

Technical Information:

HSDEI's will be numbered similar to chapter divisions of the MUTCD. For example, if a HSDEI provides guidance on a traffic signal issue, it will be numbered HSDEI 11 (YEAR) - 4XX. The topical numbering system will be as follows:

001 - 099	General operating procedures
100 - 199	General design guidance not covered in another section
200 - 299	Sign and sign post design guidance
300 - 399	Pavement marking and delineation guidance
400 - 499	Traffic signal design and operation guidance
600 - 699	Work zone traffic control design and operation guidance
700 - 799	Traffic control for school areas

800 - 899	Traffic controls for highway-rail grade crossings
900 - 999	Traffic controls for bicycle facilities

Use of the above numbering system should assist people when locating guidance on specific topics.
