### **Goal Statement**

<u>Overall Project Goal:</u> Develop a comprehensive improvement plan that identifies opportunities to enhance bicycle accommodations on the highestranked bicycle corridors on the State highway system. This comprehensive plan is being developed in three phases.

- Phase I (current phase): Through a combination of stakeholder outreach and quantitative analysis, develop a robust road segment categorization scheme that classifies the state highway system into three or four bicycle route tiers based on their location, connectivity, and desirability.
- Phase II: Identify critical infrastructure deficiencies and gaps in the top-tier bicycle corridors.
- Phase III: Identify specific improvements (e.g., signage, striping, widening, etc.) to address the identified gaps in the top-tier bicycle corridors.





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#### **Project Purpose**

#### THREE KEY COMPONENTS

- This project helps prioritize investment decisions
- By identifying important state roadways for bicycling
- Public input is a big part of how these are chosen

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




# Where would Vermonters be comfortable riding?



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

- Pavement condition







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
# **Combining the information to prioritize roads**

#### **OVERVIEW**

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- Identify desirable roads
  - These are roads with strong demand
- · Adjust based on suitability
  - Directs limited resources to desirable places requiring minimal intervention first





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The Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) is developing an On-Road Bicycle Plan in support of enhancing on-road bicycle improvements on the State highways. The VTrans On-Road Bicycle Plan is a planning effort using public input and roadway characteristics to categorize state highway conidors into several tiers. The tier system will rank the state highway conforts for on-road bicycling based on where bicyclists ride now and where bicyclists want to ride. The Plan will assist VTrans in understanding where to focus limited resources towards bicycle impowements and allow better integration into Agency projects.

#### Public Input -Interactive WikiMapping Tool

A WikiMapping Tool is being used to collect public input on the primary notes bicycled across the state and obstacles for bicyclists to access prefered destinations. The information we are collecting is focused on the State highway system and segments of town highways functioning as an extension of State highways. Please ensure some portion of the routes drawn on the WikiMap include State roads (shown in blue). Cick below to get started.
