

VERMONT PUBLIC TRANSIT POLICY PLAN- STUDY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The intent of the Study Advisory Committee (SAC) is to ensure that a broad spectrum of stakeholders and organizations representing transit riders advise and assist the Project Management Team with further refinement of the Vermont Public Transit Policy Plan (PTPP). The SAC shall be comprised of representatives from VTrans, Agency of Human Services (AHS), the Agency of Commerce and Community Development (ACCD), the Vermont Public Transit association (VPTA), and other key stakeholders. The SAC shall serve as the project’s steering committee to provide review, input, and feedback on the contents of the plan as it is developed. The SAC is one component of a robust engagement plan.
