AOT Reopens More State Roads and Continues Recovery Work

Barre, Vt. – The Agency of Transportation (AOT) has reopened an additional five state roads/interstates in the past 24 hours.

State roads that have reopened since Saturday 7/15 at 6 p.m.:

- I-91 southbound just north of Exit 2 in Brattleboro
- US-302 in Orange near Reservoir Road
- VT 100 in Ludlow south of the Village to VT 155 in Weston
- VT 110 in Washington between Creamery Road and Carrier Road
- VT 125 in Ripton

At this time, 11 state roads remain closed, 13 state roads are partially open to one lane of traffic, and 91 state roads have been reopened that were previously closed due to damage from the storm early last week.
