

Construction Update on Middlebury Rail Bridges Project – July 14, 2017

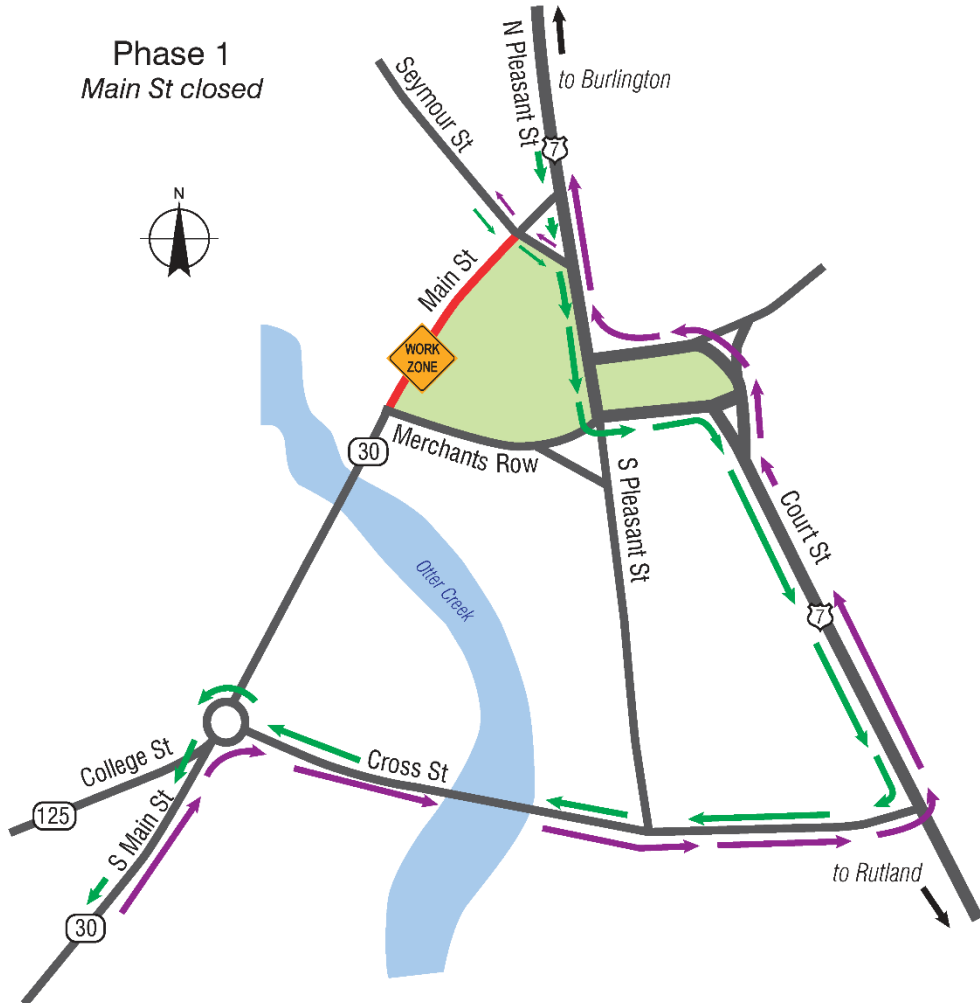
Next Friday, July 21, Main Street (VT Route 30) in downtown Middlebury will be closed between Seymour Street and Merchants Row. The road will be closed for about two weeks to enable the Vermont Agency of Transportation to build a temporary bridge over the railroad to ensure the safety of travelers until a permanent bridge is built in 2018 through 2020.

This weekend there will be NO construction activity. Middlebury's premier summer event, Festival on the Green concludes its week-long run on the Village Green with midday shows on Friday and Saturday and evening concerts on Friday and Saturday.
