

Construction Update Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project – next 2 weeks November 19-30

The next two weeks the contractor for the Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project will concentrate on off-roadway work. The contractor has completed excavation of the third and last tunnel for the stormwater drainage system. It took three months to tunnel through 422 feet of bedrock, soil, rock and clay. The next task will be to install carrier pipes within the steel casing of the tunnels.

Other upcoming work will include construction of a headwall adjacent to the Middlebury waterfalls and Otter Creek on the lower level of Marble Works Green.

There will be no effects on Main Street (Route 30) and Merchant Row traffic. Travelers may experience minor, intermittent delays as construction vehicles enter and exit the work zone at the Marble Works area.
