

Construction Update Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project Week of October 22-26

Next week (Oct 22-26) there will be more work activity that will impact traffic in downtown Middlebury than has occurred in the last few months. Here's what's planned.

- There may be brief, intermittent delays as construction vehicles enter and exit the work zone at Triangle Park.
- Merchants Row will be closed to through traffic at the temporary bridge Wednesday through Friday while the contractor digs an 8-foot deep trench for a conduit that will house overhead wires (electric and telecom) that would be in the way of cranes needed for construction of the tunnel in 2020. Parking in the lower section of Merchants Row (in front of the Battell Block) and access to the Battell Block parking lot will not be affected.
- On Friday, there will be one-way alternating traffic on Main Street (Route 30) during paving of the temporary bridge.
