

**Construction Update Middlebury Bridge and Rail Project  
Week of September 10, 2018**

Hello,

On Monday (September 10) there will be one stop of traffic on Main Street (Route 30) and Merchants Row in downtown Middlebury, for blasting to remove ledge for the Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project. Traffic delay may last up to five minutes.

The blasting site is at the rail line area near Triangle Park. The blasting will be required to remove ledge from an area where a future drainage structure will be installed.

All traffic – motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians will not be allowed to travel on Main Street/Route 30, between Seymour Street and Main Street/Merchants Row intersection, and on Merchants Row, between South Pleasant Street and Main Street/Merchants Row intersection, while the contractor for the Middlebury Bridge & Rail Project performs the blasting.

Motorists may notice an uptick in truck activity at Triangle Park which may cause brief, intermittent delays as trucks enter and exit the work site.
