Hello,

Next week (May 21-25) the contractor will continue drilling holes around a 40-foot diameter pit at the former Lazarus site, located between the bank and post office on Main Street, next to Printer's Alley. The pit will accommodate a new drainage system that will extend some 38 feet below ground and, once complete, will remove standing water from the rail corridor as well as receive stormwater from downtown streets. It will take about three weeks to finish this work.

Pedestrian access between Main Street and the Marble Works through Printer's Alley will be maintained throughout the project and flaggers will manage the flow of vehicles in and out of the Lazarus foundation area and the National Bank's parking lot.

Motorists and pedestrians should travel through the work area with caution. Motorists are advised that speeding through a construction zone can lead to increased fines.
