Welded Wire Fabric Safety Fence

Ithaca, NY



Welded Wire Galvanized

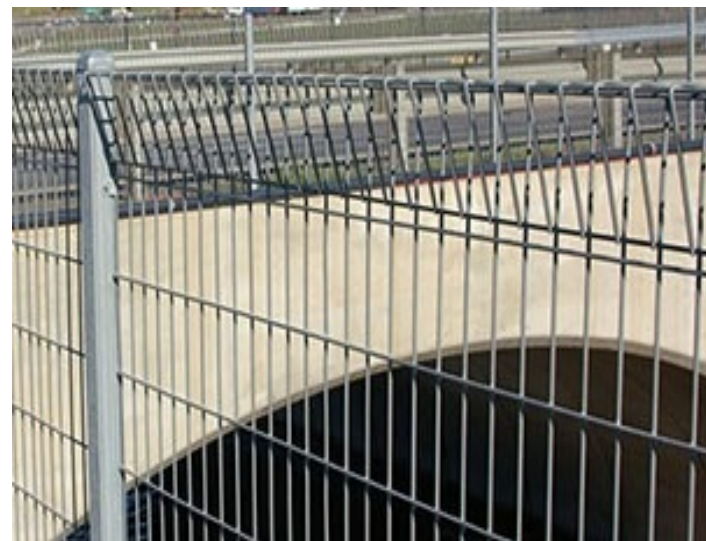
Option considered & dismissed

Advantage

- Wire may be thinner than, more aesthetic

Disadvantage

- Not as sturdy as chain link
- Less functional as a safety fence



Chain Link Safety Fence

Three coating options:

- Galvanized
- Black vinyl coated
- Green vinyl coated

Preserving Views

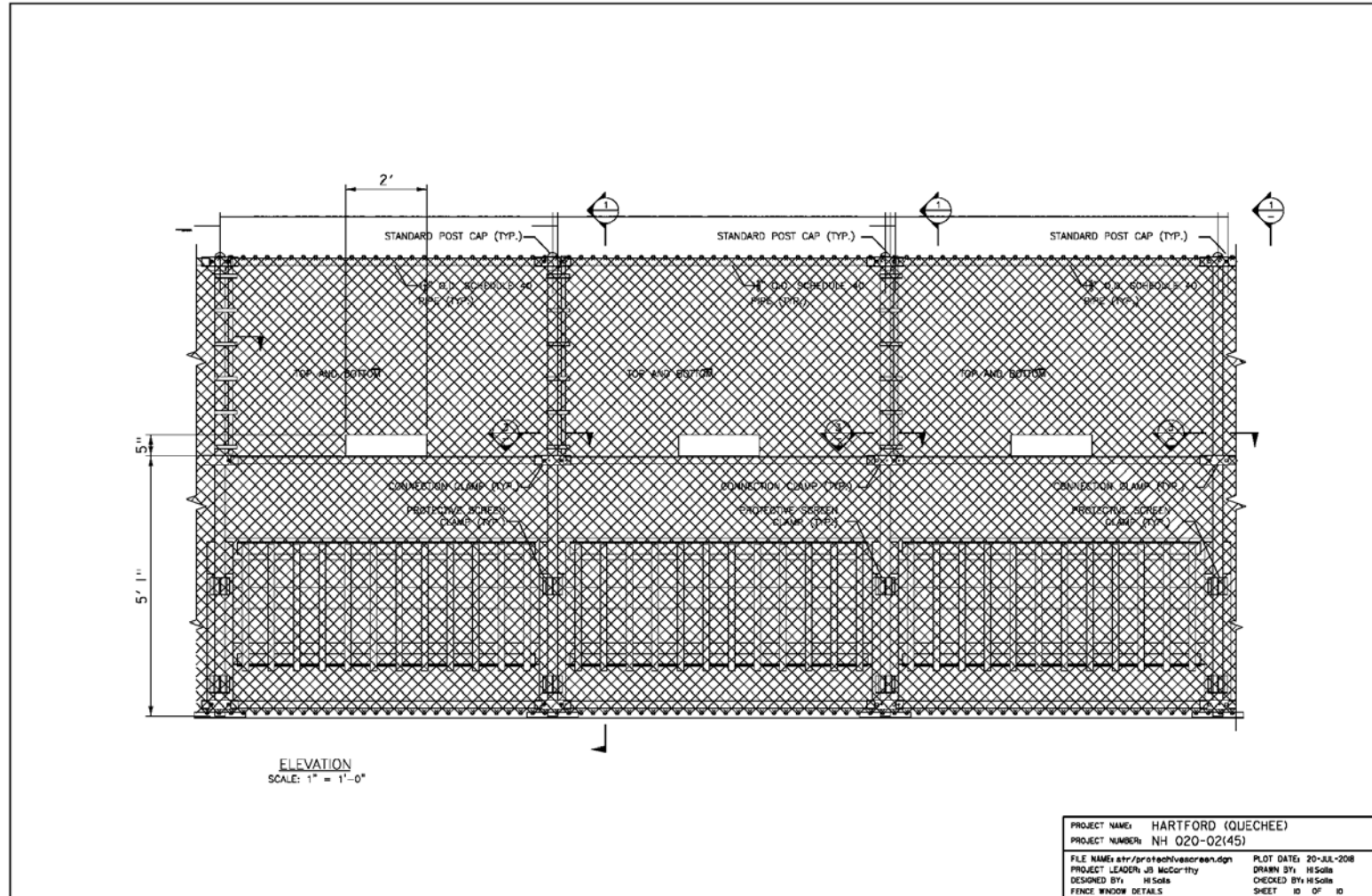
- Specs include windows in fence for photos and viewing.
- 2-feet long, 5 inches wide.
- 8 windows in temporary fence on each side.

July 25-27: Project Advertised for construction bids.

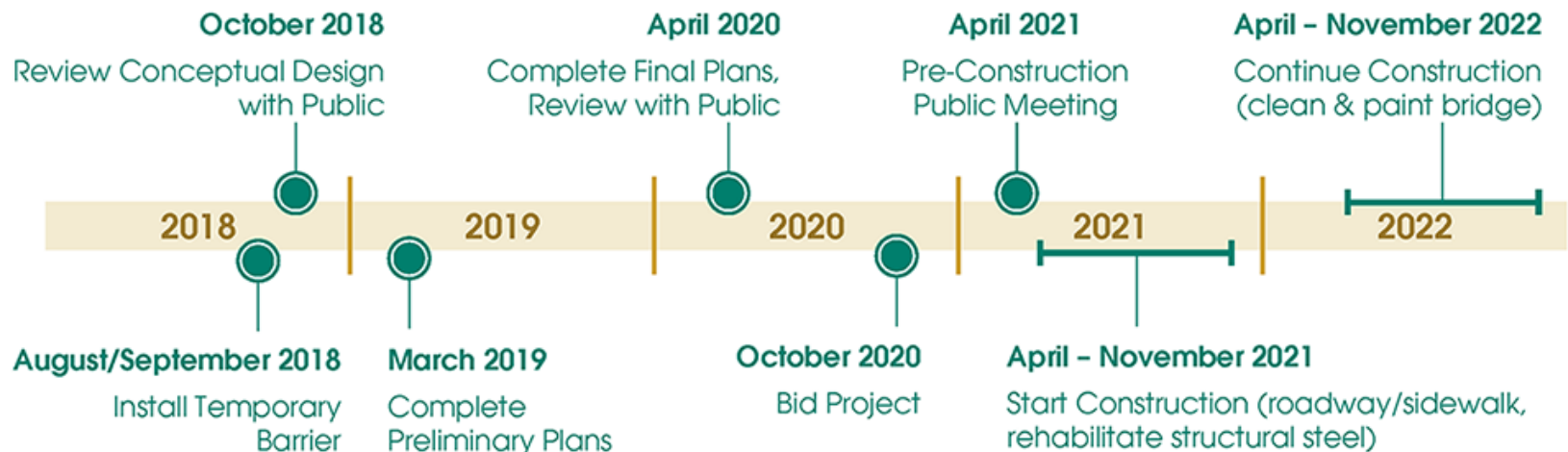
August 10: Bid Opening
