

Quechee Gorge Bridge Construction Spring Construction Continues



Construction Update

All work is occurring in the closed eastbound lane. Traffic continues with alternating travel over the bridge, controlled by a traffic signal. This closure and one-way alternating traffic will continue until mid-season when the closure will switch sides to the westbound lane.

Next week there will be occasional stoppages in the travelling lane to allow concrete trucks to enter the staging area. Also, sometime soon there will also be a minor delay as workers re-erect the pedestrian sidewalk fence on the north side.

The pedestrian fence that separates the northern sidewalk from the travel lane has been removed to make space for winter maintenance.

Hiking Near the Bridge

For those traveling by foot, the trail is closed at the bridge underpass through the fall of 2025. The adjacent trail is open via a signed detour through the visitor center. Like last year, the contractor is using the southwest parking area as a staging site.
