

Quechee Gorge Bridge Construction Spring Construction Continues



Construction Update

In early March 2025, the contractor resumed work on the Quechee Gorge Bridge. All work is occurring in the closed eastbound lane. Traffic continues with alternating travel over the bridge, controlled by a traffic signal. This closure and one-way alternating traffic will continue until mid-season when the closure will switch sides to the westbound lane.

The existing travel lane is now 15-feet wide to allow for snow plows to fit within it. The pedestrian fence that separates the northern sidewalk from the travel lane has been removed to make space for winter maintenance. The fence will be re-erected after the winter snow season has passed, most likely in mid-April 2025.

Mid-week next week, likely on April 1st and/or April 2nd depending on weather, the contractor will have flaggers in the road to control traffic while the concrete barrier is moved on the bridge.

Hiking Near the Bridge

For those traveling by foot, the trail is closed at the bridge underpass through the fall of 2025. The adjacent trail is open via a signed detour through the

visitor center. Like last year, the contractor is using the southwest parking area as a staging site.
